

Creating Accessible and Inclusive Communities

Phase 1 Engagement Summary

City of Moreton Bay is developing a new Disability Access and Inclusion Plan to help guide our journey toward becoming a highly accessible and inclusive city.



Engagement Snapshot

Between July and August 2025:

- 154 people completed the survey
- 1151 visitors to the project website
- 29 people participated in a focus group or interview



Participant Demographics

- 50% identified as a person with disability
- 91% lived in City of Moreton Bay
- Focus group and interview participants included people with lived experience of disability, carers, families, service providers, and peak bodies



Key Insights

- You said social inclusion is connected to access, accessibility, social opportunities and the financial capacity to participate. Without access and accessibility needs being met, economic inclusion is compromised
- There is strong interest in ongoing partnership and collaboration with Council
- While progress has been made, significant access and inclusion issues remain
- Council has a role to play in the inclusion of people with disability
